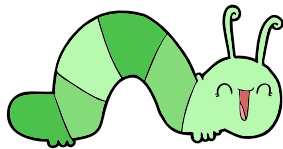

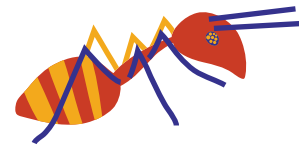
Print off the cards below. Cut them out and sort them into three categories: animals that spend the most time in the air, on the land, and in water.

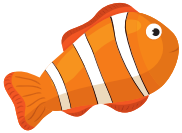

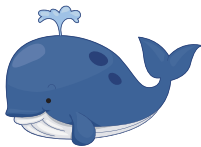
